

# Fall Assembly Action Committee Reports

## November 5, 2011

### MEMBERSHIP OUTREACH

**Challenge:** Strengthen personal relationships across Al-Anon and Alateen groups and local AA groups.

**Purpose/goal of challenge:** To strengthen personal relationships in the fellowship and refresh group programs with new perspectives.

**Action:** Encourage cross group activities.

- Multi-Group Workshops.
- Multi-District Workshops.
- Make use of District and AIS speaker lists to bring in outside speakers to groups.
- Designate a member to attend other group meetings and invite them to your events.
- Support Alateen groups and invite Alateens to speak at Al-Anon events and meetings.

### PUBLIC OUTREACH

**Challenge:** Encourage individual members to become involved in public outreach efforts.

**Action:** Each group and/or district (depending on size and feasibility) create a bookmark, listing all local meetings. Use non-threatening language as found in WSO and CAL literature. Have each member distribute at least six bookmarks.

### FELLOWSHIP COMMUNICATION

**Challenge:** Sharing our voices through writing.

**Purpose/goal of challenge:** Share our experience, strength and hope through writing.

**Action:** Create a list of avenues to send writings and pictures to.

**Action:** Have a quarterly writing meeting where topics are chosen and members are encouraged to share their experience strength and hope in writing format during the meeting.

**Challenge:** Implement CAL (conference Approved Literature).

**Purpose/goal of challenge:** Education, awareness and encouragement to use CAL.

**Action:** Meetings on “Why Conference Approved Literature” brochure as topic.

**Action:** Literature meetings.

**Action:** Meetings on history of literature.

**Action:** A monthly meeting using “The Forum” as topic.

## **GROUP SERVICES**

**Challenge:** GR to meet another GR from another District; exchange information or whatever.

**Purpose/goal of challenge:** Communication outside of our own District.

**Action:** Meet another GR – someone you do not know!!

**Challenge:** Fill out information on Board for each District – District Website, Hotline #, AIS Website, etc.

**Purpose/goal of challenge:** Gather all area hotlines; unify groups and present flyer in May with all information gathered in English and Spanish.

**Action:** To complete the challenge

## **ALATEEN ACTION COMMITTEE**

**Challenge:** All districts make posters, bookmarks, etc. with Alateen group meeting information. Distribute them to public places, i.e. schools and counselors.

**Purpose/goal of challenge:** To get the word out.

**Challenge:** All districts to host/facilitate an open Alateen/Al-Anon workshop
